THREE OPTIONS COURSES

BE VERY CAREFUL IN SELECTING YOUR THREE OPTIONS COURSES. THE UNIVERSITY YOU PLAN TO ATTEND MAY INFLUENCE WHICH COURSES YOU CHOOSE. THE CHART BELOW INDICATES WHICH OPTIONS COURSES YOU SHOULD TAKE FOR THE UNIVERSITIES LISTED WITH WHICH WE HAVE TRANSFER AGREEMENTS. IF YOU ELECT TO ATTEND A UNIVERSITY OTHER THAN THOSE LISTED, YOU SHOULD CONSULT WITH THAT UNIVERSITY TO DETERMINE WHICH THREE COURSES YOU SHOULD CHOOSE.

CLUSTERS

Clusters are designed to allow the student to pick interrelated courses that will supplement their major and/or career path goals. Students planning on pursuing a Masters of Accountancy Degree should complete the Cluster in Business indicated below, and one other cluster which could be structured around the transfer school requirements. An example would be Math 119 to meet the requirements of Utah State University, or Math 110 or higher to meet the requirements of Idaho State University (Math 221 does not meet this requirement).

CPA CONSIDERATIONS

Students desiring to sit for the CPA exam will need an additional year of study since nearly all states require 150 credit hours of college preparation to sit for the exam. Those desiring CPA certification should transfer to another university upon graduation from BYU-Idaho to obtain a MAcc Degree or an MBA Degree.
