**General Information:**

(A certain number of "major electives" may be required for your major, but you can select which course to choose from the given list.)

Each plan includes all required courses, including Foundations and major as well as emphasis, minor or clusters (if applicable). The plan may also include elective courses to meet the credit requirement.
