

CAMPUS SNOW POLICY

09 November, 2005

Because of winter snow conditions, the City of Rexburg and the University have set rules for streets and on Campus parking lots. They are:

- 1 November to 1 March there is a no parking on city streets law, enforced on all city streets, between the hours of 2 a.m. to 7 a.m. Police Officers will issue citations to owners of vehicles left on the street unless they are going to be in the way of snow removal equipment that is working in that area. If vehicles are in the immediate way of snow removal equipment, officers will make a reasonable effort to contact the owners to have their vehicles moved off the street. If contact cannot be made with the owners the vehicle will be towed to an impound lot. The owner will have to pay towing charges to get their vehicle back.
- Most interior streets on Campus are city streets and fall under the above rules.
- Campus parking lots are owned by the Campus and fall under Campus rules. There are two parking lots that are overnight parking. They are the Pioneer girls dorm parking lot and the Ensign boys dorm parking lots. These are by permit only.
- All other parking lots are closed from 1 a.m. to 4 a.m. for cleaning year round. A reasonable effort will be made to contact the owners of the vehicles to have them moved. If contact can not be made with the owner, vehicles left in these parking lots will be cited by Security personnel and or towed by the snow removal crews, at the owners expense to a tow companies impound lot. Owners will pay to get their vehicles back.
- Reasonable effort means: Taking information from the license plate, the parking permits or other identification visible and by either calling police dispatch or Campus dispatch, and attempt to find the owners name and phone number. If the owners name is different from the vehicle registered owner or cannot be connected with a student, we have no way to contact the person operating that vehicle. The vehicle will then be cited and or towed.
