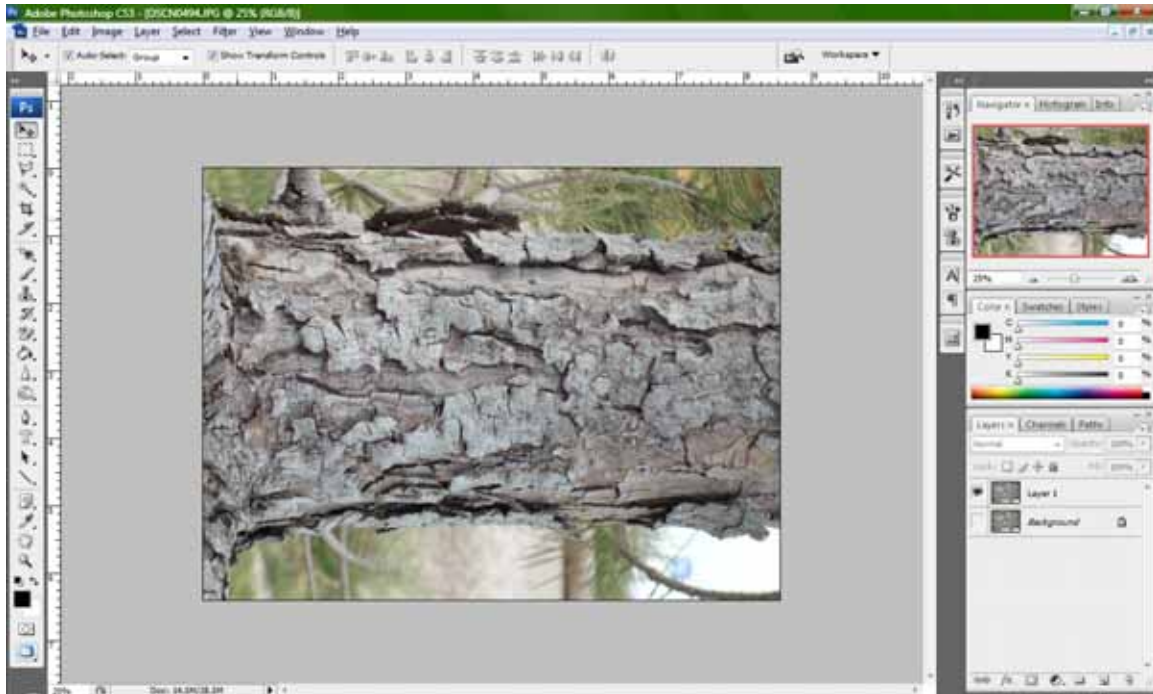
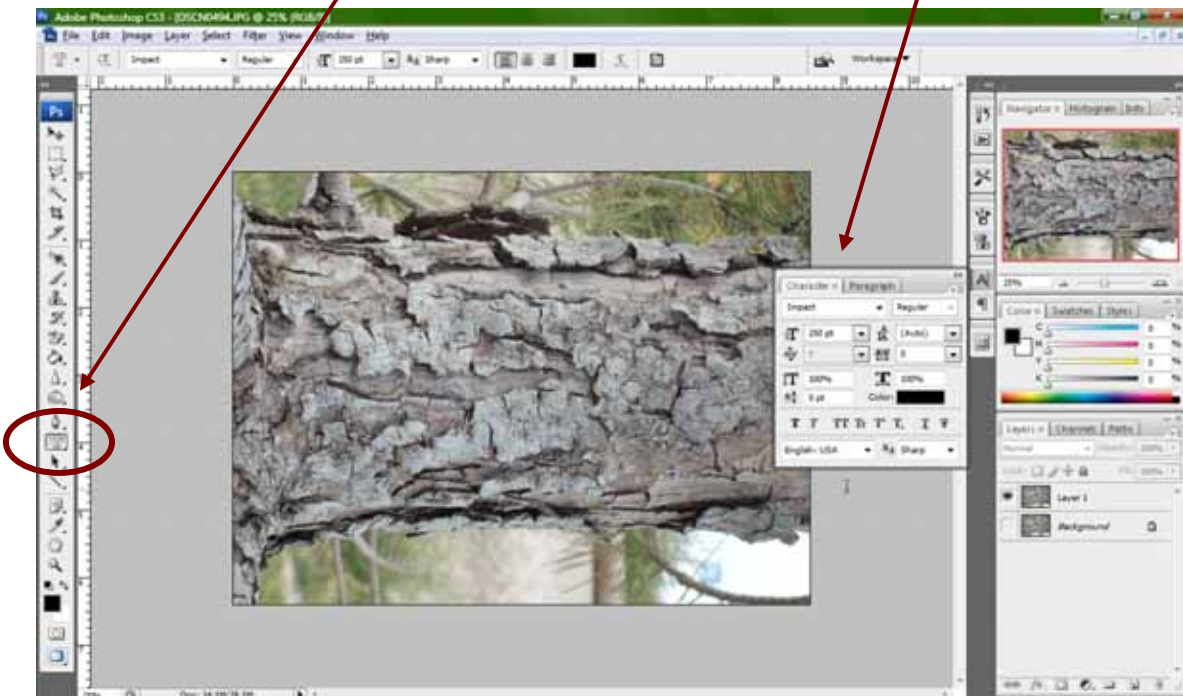


# Textured Text

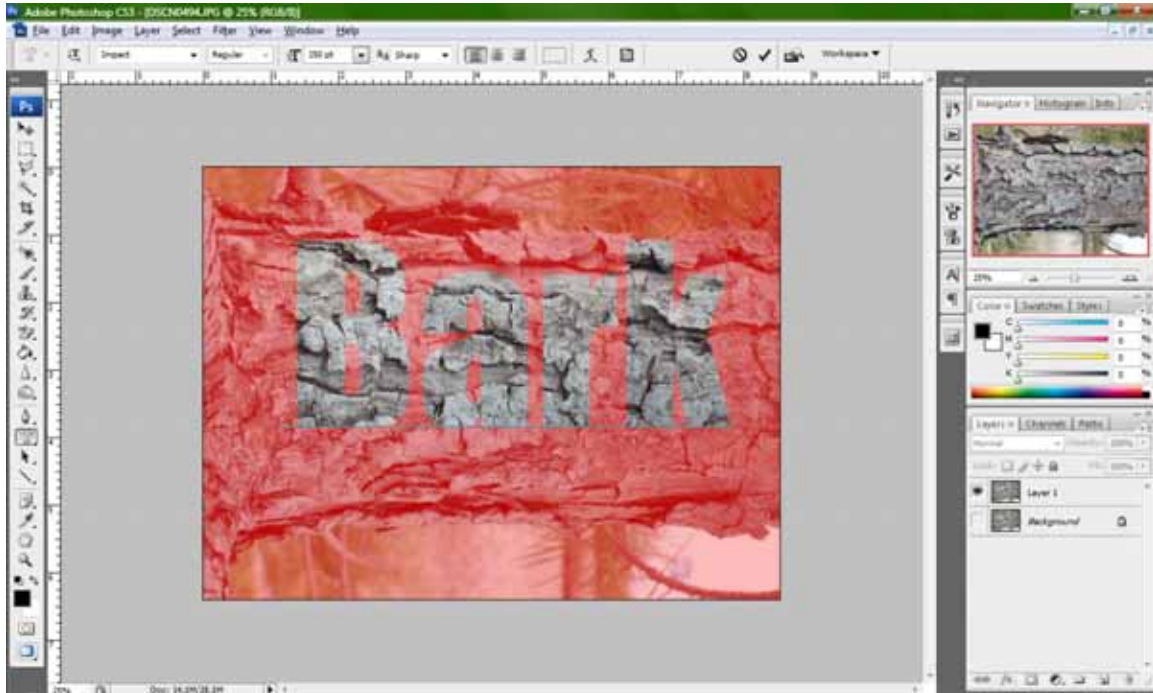
Open a textured image in Photoshop.



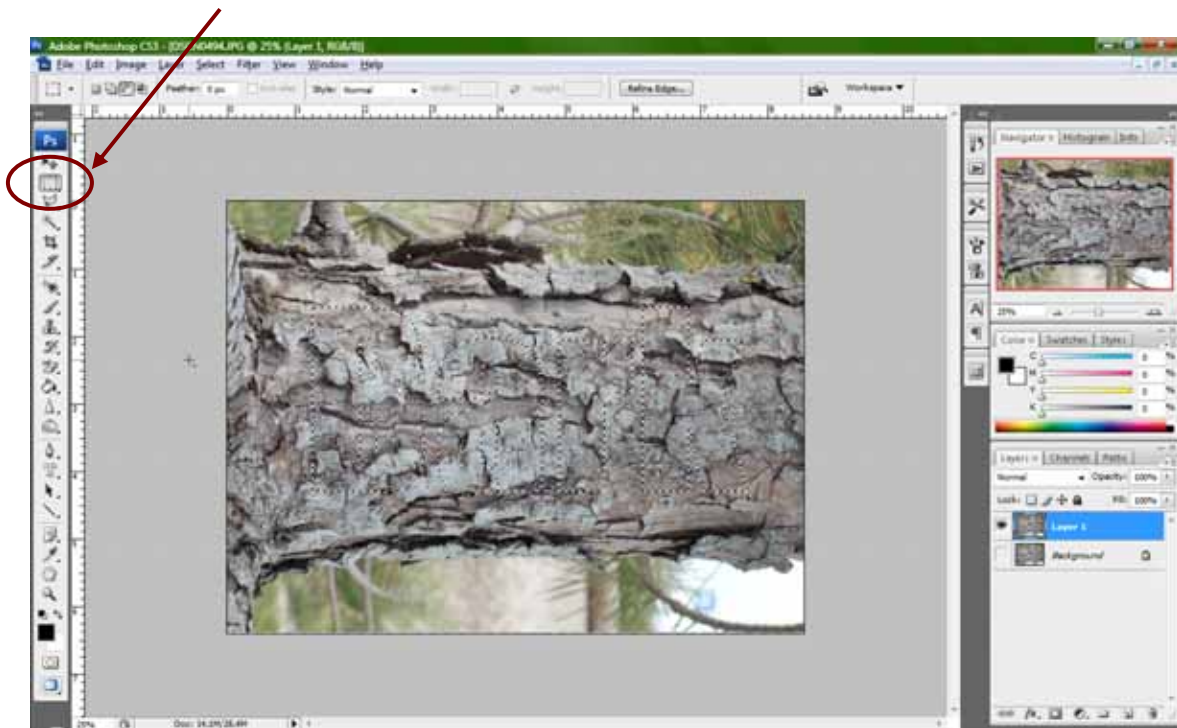
Then select the Horizontal Type Mask Tool. From there select a bold font such as Impact. Change the character options to make the font type large.

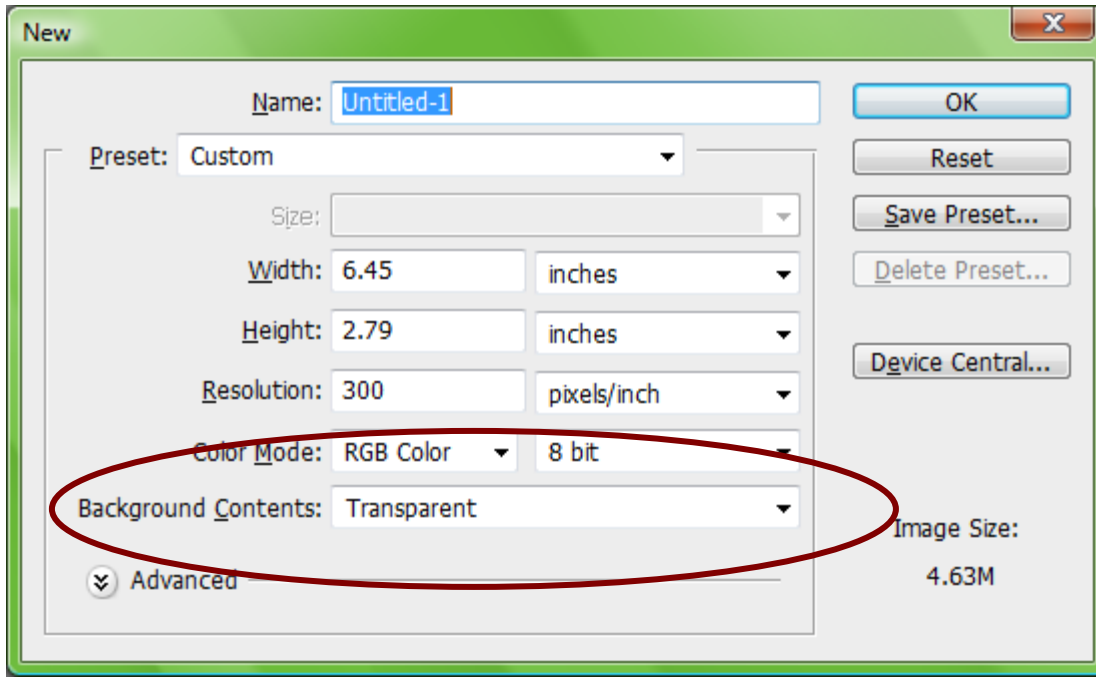


Type the desired text.

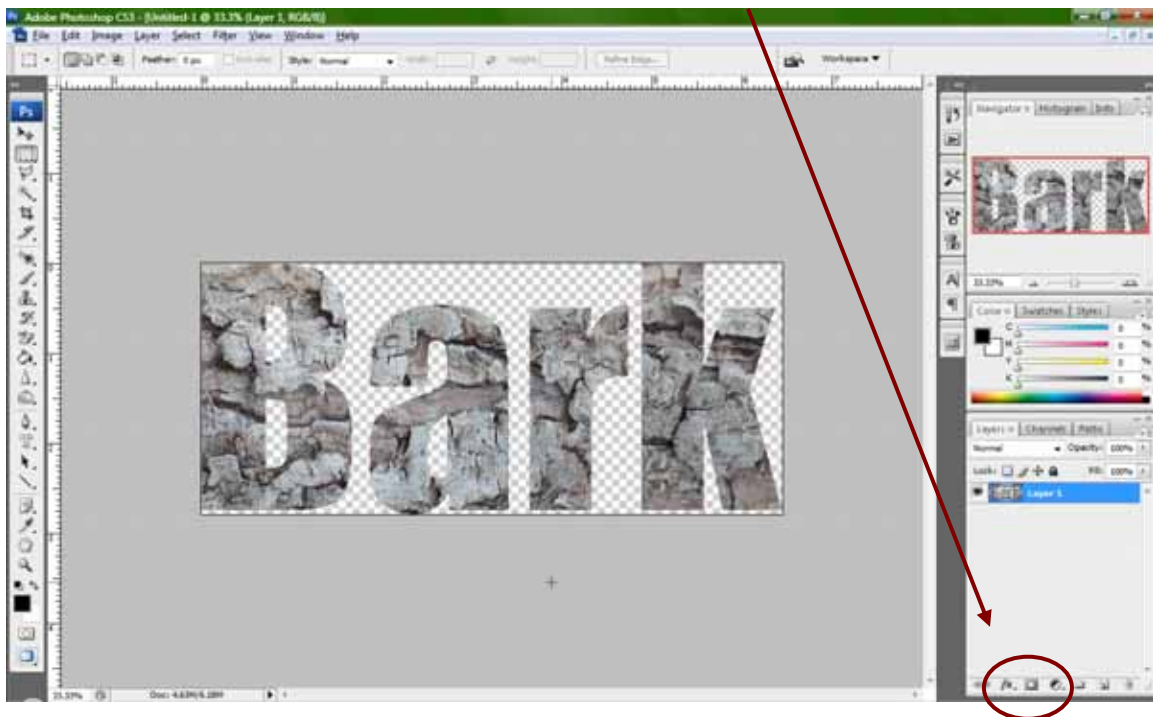


From there use the Marquee Tool to grab the text and move it to the desired area of the image. From there, copy (Edit-Copy or cmd-C) the image and open a new document (File-New). When opening the new document just make sure the Background Contents is Transparent.

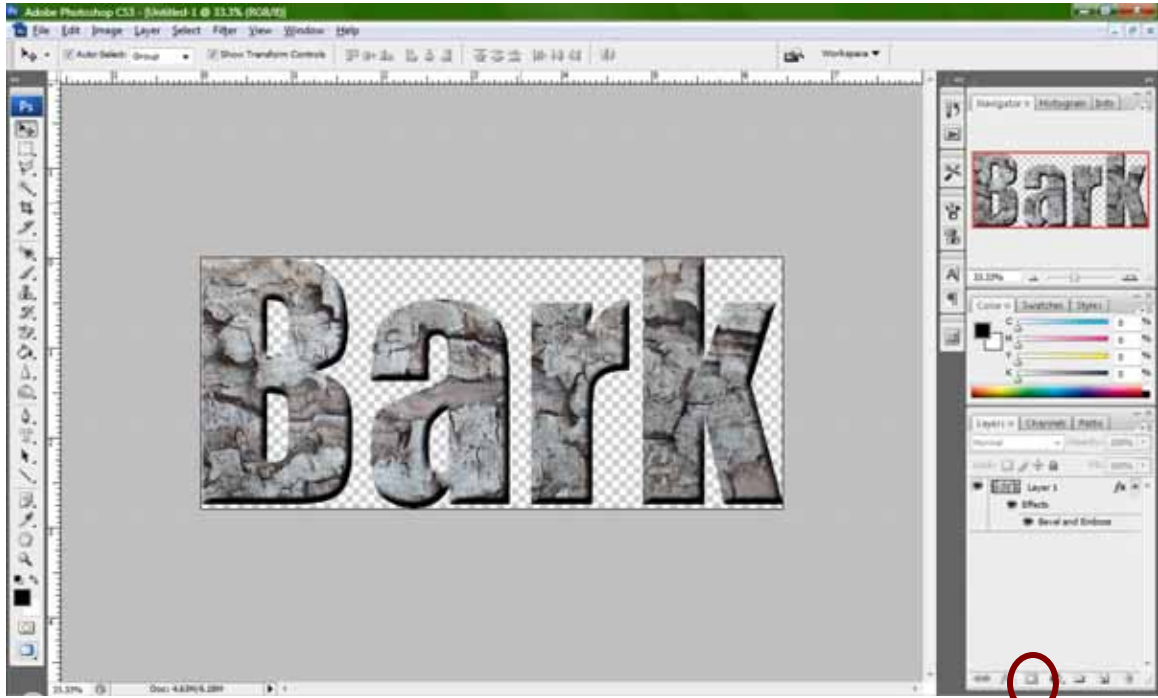




After you get the new document open either select cmd V or go up to Edit-Paste to paste the outlined text into the document. After you get the image into the new document you can experiment with Layer Styles to help enhance the text.



Once your text has been modified to your liking you can then save it and place it into another image to help enhance the look and feel of the image you are creating.



\* You may want to play with the mask tool on this one. You can delete certain areas of the text to really add an interesting affect to it!
