Many of today’s children are spoiled, tell their parents “no,” and are free to do whatever they want in the name of “agency.” This class will help parents take the bull by the horns, rise up, and be the parents they want to be!

<b>Richard Openshaw</b> <b>Description:</b>	<i>Series 1</i> <b>The Family: A Proclamation to the World, Part 1</b> The Family: A Proclamation to the World is one of the most significant documents revealed in our day. Its simplicity yet its complexity are there for us to use as a road map to marriage and family success. President Henry B. Eyring stated shortly after the proclamation was read; “Because our Father loves his children, he will not leave us to guess about what matters most in this life concerning where our attention could bring happiness or our indifference could bring sadness... he will, tell us these important matters through his servants.” (Elder Henry B. Eyring The Family, Ensign, Feb. 1998, p. 10) This great document is the central core for a new course taught at BYU-Idaho as part of the Foundations classes now required for all incoming students. It takes from the Proclamation, six major guiding principles and uses them to teach sound doctrine and eternal truths relating to the family unit.

The Jews defended themselves through religious and political responses to defend themselves. Political Zionism hoped to establish a Jewish State in Palestine, but what would happen to the millions of Arabs already living there? Following World War One, the British government took charge of Palestine under a mandate from the League of Nations. The purpose of the mandate was to help Palestine develop stable self-government. Why did the mandate fail, and how is the failure related to current problems? The conflict between Israel and her Arab neighbors is often viewed as primarily a religious conflict. To what extent is that view accurate, and how else might the conflict be viewed. These conflicts will be discussed in this series.

*Series 2*      **Virtual Tour of India**  
Civilization first arose in India in the second millennium BC with the founding of the ancient cities of Harappa and Mohenjo-Daro on the Indus River. We will view several of the great Hinduism, Buddhism, and Sikhism temples of these three important Indian religious traditions. Shah Jehan, one of the Mughal rulers of northern India, built the Taj Mahal, one of the wonders of the world as a tomb for his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal. We will view this and other magnificent structures built in modern times.

*Series 3*      **Understanding Islam**  
This lecture explores the life of Muhammad and the founding of Islam based upon historical sources, *Ensign* articles, First Presidency statements, and *Preach My Gospel*.
