

Place Names

What is the correct name of the locality at the time of the event?!!!

Proper Structure of a Place Name: (include all government levels)

- 1st level: town/township/city/parish
- 2nd level: correct county *for the date of the event*
- 3rd level: correct state/province *for the date of the event*
- 4th level: correct country *for the date of the event*

General Housekeeping:

- ✓ **of**, when an event took place in that area. (Place a comma after of, so software programs don't read it as part of the name of a city/town.)
- ✓ **< >** Brackets - possibility or assumed. If events of other family members happened in that place...
- ✓ **Blank** – Leave the field blank if unknown and put your ideas in the notes
- ✓ **Spaces and commas for missing levels---** (Marsing, , Idaho, USA)
- ✓ **No "County" or "Co."** necessary when all the levels are represented in some way.
- ✓ **No abbreviations** except for USA
- ✓ **Names of cemeteries, hospitals, religions, landmarks, etc.** should be in notes

Place Names are Time Sensitive:

If the event was pre-statehood, use "America" instead of "USA". (See back for statehood dates.)
