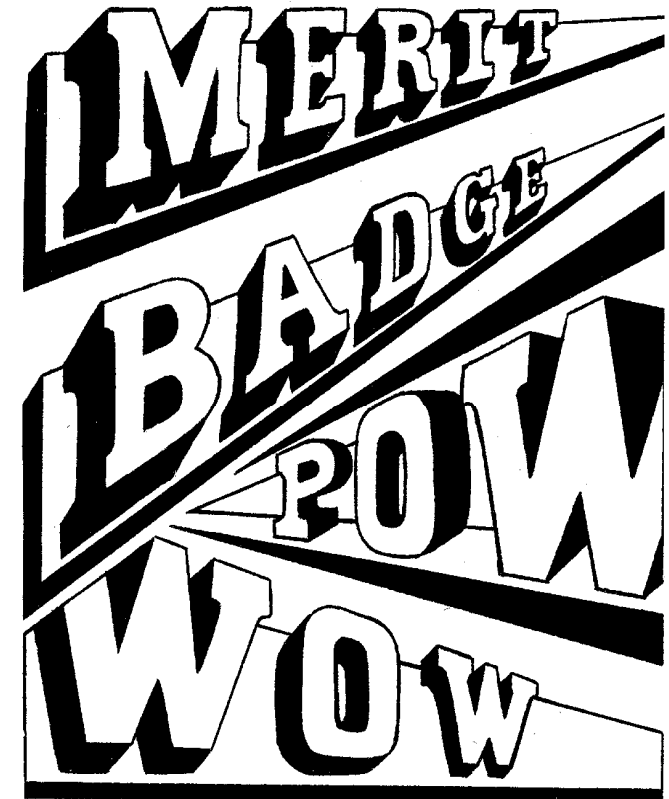

The Department of Continuing Education is once again excited to offer the annual Scout Merit Badge Powwow to be held on Saturday, November 7, 2009. This year the Powwow will be a one-day event. This change has been made for a number of reasons; namely:

- Travel cost for outlying districts will be minimized
- More focused classroom time
- Commitment from counselors

The one-day format will require dedicated preparation beforehand and some follow up afterward, on the part of the Scouts.
