**Wood Carving**  
**Requirements Sheet**  
**Merit Badge Powwow 2009**

The scout is to read the Wood Carving Merit Badge pamphlet before the Powwow (2006 edition or later). Some requirements may take up to 90 days to complete before coming to the Powwow. Read all the requirements below and bring necessary items to guarantee passing off the merit badge on the day of the Powwow. Bring to class paper, pen or pencil, and any other items asked for. Write your name, merit badge and class time (9:00 or 1:00) on **every** paper or project. (If there are any questions pertaining to requirements, the most recent Boy Scout Requirements handbook will always be used).

**Recommended Requirments to complete before Powwow**

- a. Bring a pocket knife to the Powwow
- b. Come prepared having read the pamphlet and getting started on your carving project will help you finish the merit badge the day of the Powwow.

**Requirments that will be passed off at the Powwow**

**Completed:**

1. Show that you know first aid for injuries or illnesses that could occur while wood carving, including minor cuts and scratches and splinters.
2. Do the following:
  - a. Earn the Totin' Chip recognition.
  - b. Discuss with your merit badge counselor your understanding of the Safety Checklist for Carving.
3. Do the following:
  - a. Explain to your counselor, orally or in writing, the care and use of five types of tools that you may use in a carving project.
  - b. Tell your counselor how to care for and use several types of sharpening devices, then demonstrate that you know how to use these devices.
4. Using a piece of scrap wood or a project on which you are working, show your merit badge counselor that you know how to do the following:
  - a. Paring cut
  - b. Basic cut and push cut
  - c. Score line
  - d. Stop cut
5. Tell why different woods are used for different projects. Explain why you chose the type of wood you did for your projects in requirements 6 and 7.
6. Plan your own or select a project from the Wood Carving merit badge pamphlet and complete a simple carving in the round.
7. Complete a simple low-relief OR a chip carving project.
