

Financial Aid Determination Date 2009-10

Pell Grants, Academic Competitive Grants, and SMART Grants are based on the number of credits you are registered for as of **MIDNIGHT** of the 23rd day of the Fall, Winter, and Summer Semesters. This is called the **FINANCIAL AID DETERMINATION DATE (FADD)**.

Important Items to Remember:

- These grants will be recalculated on the FADD to take into account any added or dropped courses.
- This recalculation may require you to owe a repayment to your grant(s), owe additional tuition, and/or receive additional grant(s).
- You must be enrolled in at least 6 credits to be eligible for your student loan.
- If you have **loans** and/or **grants** and you **COMPLETELY WITHDRAW** before midnight of the FADD, **all aid will be canceled and you will be required to return all funds.**
- If BYU-Idaho received the results of your FAFSA application (Student Aid Report) after the FADD, your grant(s) will be based on enrollment as of the day your financial aid application is processed.

Important Enrollment Tips:

- If you have full semester courses and 2nd block classes, you must be registered for the block classes by the Full Semester FADD to have 2nd block classes considered for grants. You will be able to receive your financial aid based on your projected enrollment for these 2nd block classes.
- However, if you receive grant money for classes that haven't started yet, for example you have full semester classes and 2nd block classes; you must be enrolled for the **2nd block classes** through midnight of the 2nd block FADD date.
- If you drop the 2nd block classes before midnight of the 2nd block FADD date, we will be required to recalculate your aid. This means you may have to return some or all of your grant/loan funds.
