**Sample Completion Plan with Foundations Courses**

The Nursing Program receives many highly qualified applicants. Students are encouraged to also contact other schools of nursing for transfer and program information.

**College Prerequisites:**

Chemistry*	General Chemistry: 4 credits	BYU-Idaho course: Chem 101
Anatomy and Physiology**	two (2 semesters): 8 credits	BYU-Idaho course: BIO 264 & BIO 265

\*(Note: Chemistry requirement may be waived with one (1) year of high school chemistry (two terms) with a grade of “B” or better in each term.  
 \*\*No high school equivalent.

Note: Final admission to the BYU-Idaho nursing program is contingent upon completion of all prerequisite courses with a “B” or better grade.

**Nursing Application Deadlines:**

Spring Semester Admission:	November 15 <sup>th</sup>
Fall Semester Admission:	March 15 <sup>th</sup>
Winter Semester Admission:	June 15 <sup>th</sup>

**Requirements for All Applicants:**

**Applications:**

- Two separate applications: One for BYU-Idaho, and one for the Nursing Program.\**
- Official H.S. transcripts**
- “Official college transcripts:”** Transfer students must submit separately to the BYU-Idaho Registrar and the Department of Nursing. **Failure to submit** the applicant’s official transcript(s) to the Department of Nursing by the application deadline, will invalidate the nursing application and the student will not be considered for admission to the nursing program.
- Students with more than 48 credits** (excluding concurrent enrollment credit earned in high school) will be considered for the Alternate Track only.

**Important Note:** The Department of Nursing does not require a different GPA from the University. HOWEVER, space is limited. The minimum GPA for the past 5 years has been 3.7. We counsel interested applicants to be aware that GPA is very important.

Nursing courses illustrated above show how a student can finish the program requirements within the 4 semester time frame. General Education courses may be taken at the student’s discretion, but all requirements for graduation must be successfully completed by the final semester of nursing courses.

A **Criminal Background Check** will be required if admitted. (A felony conviction may disqualify an applicant).

It is important to know that once accepted in the A.S.N. Program, anything which changes your educational plan (travel, illness, marriage, childbirth, failure of a course, ANYTHING) may delay your reentry into the program by as much as a year. Students are admitted on a “space available” basis. **Additionally, a single failure in a nursing course will result in dismissal from the program.**

- All transfer credits must be officially cleared by the BYU-Idaho Registrar’s Office. **The student is responsible to ensure their classes are equivalent to BYU-Idaho courses and credits.**
- Religion 121 and 122 (Book of Mormon) and 200 are university graduation requirements. A total of 8 Religion credits are required for an associates degree.
- Students will be admitted on all three tracks. Students are admitted to their assigned track. Once admitted, students complete the nursing program in 4 straight semesters.
- Once admitted to the Nursing Program, students will continue through all semesters until the Associate Degree is completed.
