Overview of BYU-Idaho's Academic Suspension Policy:

Please review the student catalog for a full explanation of this policy.

Suspended students are denied continued enrollment at BYU-Idaho. A suspended student who desires to return to BYU-Idaho must first complete both of the following conditions in order to have the academic suspension lifted:

1. Sit out from BYU-Idaho for a minimum of twelve months. Unless seeking an exception, students may not petition to return to BYU-Idaho until the entire twelve months have elapsed.
- AND**
2. Complete 12 semester (18 quarter) credits with a minimum 2.0 GPA at another college or university or complete a full-time mission for the Church after the suspension occurred.

IMPORTANT NOTE: A second academic suspension may lead to academic dismissal from BYU-Idaho.
