

Under the provisions of the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, students have the right to withhold directory information. Students desiring to block personally identifiable information may choose from two options:

Option 1: Withhold the release of any personal identifiable information and reference of attendance at this University. This prohibits the University from releasing any personal identifiable information and acknowledging attendance to any outside entity.

Option 2: Withhold the release of all personal identifiable information in campus directories. This allows verifications of attendance and other allowed information to authorized outside entities.

Please note that in order to prevent information in the written directory, this notice must be completed within 10 days of the start of the Fall Semester.

BYU-Idaho honors this request, and assumes no liability for honoring this request. The request remains active until otherwise indicated by rescinding this request by the student by signature.
