**General Information:**

(A certain number of "major electives" may be required for your major, but you can select which course to choose from the given list)

- \*\*\*A student must have completed at least 20 credits of Automotive courses before registering for AUTO 340.
- #Complete FDINT 201-203 if a FDHUM course was previously taken; complete FDWLD 201 if FDWLD 101 was taken.
- ^Take only if total credits are under 120 credits.

Automotive students must be on a winter track; if you are not on a winter track (fall/winter or winter/spring), please see the Advising Office in Austin 106C, 496-2043.
