Talent Award Portfolio Guidelines

Before the Review

Make sure that all required steps listed below are met and then deliver the portfolio and other materials to Spori 316 in advance of the scheduled closing time. Late work will NOT be accepted. Students are not allowed to remain in the review rooms.

After the Review

Portfolios should be picked up at the specified time to avoid having work lost or damaged. Please be patient. The approvals from the BYU-Idaho Office of Financial Aid and Scholarship can take one to two months. Please do not contact individual instructors or the Department office about the results of the review.

Transfer Student Information and Mailed Portfolio Information

Transfer students must include a copy of their transcript. If an applicant mails his or her portfolio and wants it returned, return postage must be included. Mail all portfolios and applications well in advance of the published deadline to the address below. Please mark the outside of the package in large letters: "**Talent Award Portfolio**". All other questions should be directed to the phone number below.

Portfolio Instructions

- 1) Complete this application
- 2) A digital portfolio should be prepared as follows:
 - a) A minimum of 8 to a maximum of 10 images of the applicant's own artwork. These images should represent a variety of subjects and media. Original artwork should not be sent.
Note: Three-dimensional work (sculpture, etc.) may have two views of a particular work, which can be added to the 10 image total.
 - b) Label all images with the applicant's name, size of original artwork, and medium.

Portfolios may be in the following formats: CD or thumb drive of digital images in a software program such as PowerPoint, Keynote, or Acrobat. It is important that files for each image be a manageable size. Please use JPEG format, with each image being no larger than 1 meg or 1024 x 768 pixels.

- 3) Finally, in order to return these portfolios to the applicant it will be necessary for the applicant to enclose an envelope as described:
 - a) Use a heavy or padded envelope large enough for the portfolio for added security.
 - b) Address it with the location to which the portfolio should be returned.
 - c) All US applicants should affix the correct amount of US Mail postage—even if you sent it to us by another delivery carrier. Do not use metered postage. Canadian and foreign applicants should not affix postage.

Current Art Student Talent Award Eligibility and Judging Criteria

- 1) Specific criteria used for awarding a talent award include a review of:
 - a) Artistic skill and performance demonstrated in the submitted work.
 - b) Student's in-class attendance, preparation, participation, and work habits.
- 2) To be competitive, a student's overall GPA should be 2.75 or higher and grades for art courses should be in the A and B range.
- 3) If a talent award is offered to a student, but their final grades for the current semester are below the required level, the talent award will be cancelled.

Additional Information

- 1) Art talent awards for continuing art students are available in limited numbers and range in amounts from \$100 to \$800 per semester.
- 2) A letter or e-mail announcing the result of the talent award review will be mailed to all applicants.
- 3) All portfolios should be picked up on the date indicated.
